WNC-041007-11: The WNC approves the Public Works & Transportation Committee motion #: WNC-PWT-032207-01: "The Public Works & Transportation Committee of the Winnetka Neighborhood Council moves to request that Councilmember Dennis Zine approve the installation of faux red brick motifs to provide crosswalk beautification and enhance the Sherman Way median strip boundaries at the following intersections: Sherman Way / DeSoto Ave; Sherman Way / Corbin Ave.

Furthermore, the Public Works & Transportation Committee of the Winnetka Neighborhood Council recommends the installation of faux red brick motifs in the crosswalks of the following intersections for the beautification of the Winnetka Business District. Winnetka Ave / Saticoy St; Saticoy St / Oso Avenue. (Motion by art Sims, Second by Edwina Hollins. Motion passed 5-0)

Motion passed Board: 10-0.
