POSSIBLE BYLAW AMENDMENTS

ARTICLE V GOVERNING BOARD

Section 1. Composition

B. Youth Board Member (1) – Open to Stakeholders between the ages of sixteen (16) and eighteen (18). If less than eighteen (18) years of age, the Youth Board Member shall be precluded from voting on matters regarding the expenditure of funds, contracts, or recommendations to enter into contracts. The Youth member shall be allowed to speak on such matters however. If the Youth Board Member is eighteen (18), the Member will be allowed to vote on financial matters if otherwise qualified.

The purpose of the Youth Board Member is to allow high school students to become involved in civic matters.

Section 4. Terms and Term Limits

- A. Board members shall serve a four (4) year term, <u>except the Youth Board Member</u>, which shall be staggered. There are no term limits.
- B. The term of a Youth Board Member shall be one (1) year, with one-year periods starting from the date of the last Board election. The Youth Board Member is appointed by the Board.

POSSIBLE BYLAW AMENDMENTS

ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

Section 2. Duties and Powers

B. The Vice-President shall serve in place of the President if the President is unable to serve or resigns; shall serve as Presiding Officer of the Board in the absence of the President; shall may chair all Ad Hoc committees consistent with Article VII Section 2 of these Bylaws; and may chair the Rules/Elections/Bylaws Committee.

ARTICLE VII COMMITTEES AND THEIR DUTIES

The Board shall establish all Standing and Ad Hoc Committees. Suggestions for committees may come from Stakeholders or from members of the Board, and the Board shall vote upon all such suggestions.

Section 2. Ad Hoc Committees – The Board may create Ad Hoc Committees as needed to deal with temporary issues lasting up to one year to be chaired by the Board Vice-President or any other Board member appointed by a majority vote of the Board present at a meeting.
